180.03 **DUTIES**.

The ventilating statute, L. 1919, c. 491, came into the laws 14 years after enactment of L. 1905, c. 166, and is an addition to and enlargement of the duties cast upon industry for the purpose of protecting the lives and health of employees, and an action at law lies against the employer in case of failure to install the needful ventilation. Applequist v Oliver Mining Co., 209 M 241, 296 NW 13.

180.05 POWERS OF INSPECTOR; DUTIES OF OWNER.

Fatal disease of the employee not having been sustained by reason of accident within coverage of employees' liability policies, employer who paid the judgment and garnisheed insurers cannot recover indemnity against latter. Golden v Lerch Bros., 211 M 30, 300 NW 207.
