BOILERS

183.375 DIVISION OF BOILER INSPECTION.

The boilers located in business buildings owned by the University of Minnesota are subject to rules promulgated by the division of boiler inspection. OAG Jan. 31, 1946 (34-G-14).

183.38 DISTRICT BOILER INSPECTOR; INSPECTIONS; EXAMINATIONS; FEES.

The person who operates the steam boiler for a community canning center must be licensed. OAG May 21, 1943 (34-G-17).

Industrial commission is empowered under section 15.042 to make rules and regulations by which the policy of sections 183.38 to 183.58 may be implemented. OAG Aug. 20, 1946 (34-F).

District boiler inspectors, being in the classified service, must be appointed from eligible lists established by the director of civil service. In the absence of the establishment of eligible lists by geographical area, appointments of district boiler inspectors may be made from state-wide eligible lists. OAG Oct. 17, 1946 (644-B).
