## **CHAPTER 218**

COMMON CARRIERS; TRANSPORTATION

## 218.25 CLAIMS, WHEN ADJUSTED AND PAID; HOW PRESENTED.

Where consignee's agent mailed a letter to the carrier identifying the shipment, describing the contents, weight and points of shipment and destination, and notified the carrier of damage, and stated that in a short time a claim would be filed, such letter was sufficient notice of claim if within the limitation of time prescribed by the statute. Minot v M. & St. L., 65 F. Supp. 293.
