AUCTIONEERS

330.01 AUCTIONEERS LICENSES, TO WHOM GRANTED.

A non-resident may not be granted an auctioneers license. OAG Nov. 5, 1943 (16-C).

Right of purchaser to repudiate a contract because "puffer" was employed at auction sale. 9 MLR 471.

330.06 UNLICENSED SALES.

Even though the auctioneer was not licensed as required by law, the defendant who at the auction sale gave his note for the purchase price, accepted the property, is liable on the note. Gunaldson v Olson, 27 M 440, 8 NW 147.
