NON-ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES

34.01 DEFINITIONS.

Chocolate flavored milk manufactured and sold as a beverage is controlled by the provisions of Chapter 34. OAG Sept. 23, 1941 (135-B-6-F).

34.02 LICENSES; EXCEPTION.

Sale of soft drinks, including non-intoxicating malt beverages, is subject to control and regulation by virtue of the state's police power. Bernick v City of Little Falls, 191 M 128, 253 NW 369; State v Comer, 207 M 93, 290 NW 434.

The seller of concentrated orange juice must be licensed by the commissioner of agriculture. OAG April 19, 1945 (135-B-6-K).
