

CHAPTER 38

COUNTY AGRICULTURAL SOCIETIES, FAIRS, AND FARM BUREAUS

38.01 COUNTY AGRICULTURAL SOCIETIES; FORMATION; GENERAL POWERS.

County agricultural associations may amend their articles under the provisions of section 300.45. OAG March 8, 1940 (92-B-1).

The renewal of the corporate existence of county agricultural societies is accomplished by compliance with the provisions of section 300.13 and more than three-fourths of the members must vote for the resolution. OAG June 13, 1944 (92-B-1).

State or local law enforcement officers have concurrent jurisdiction with the fair police in policing the fair grounds. 1940 OAG 106, July 15, 1940 (772c-4).

Funds of county agricultural societies cannot be diverted to unauthorized purposes. OAG May 1, 1946 (772-A).

38.02 AID TO COUNTY AGRICULTURAL SOCIETIES.

Mandamus is the proper remedy to compel the state auditor to award the proper amount to the society entitled to the award. State ex rel v Iverson, 120 M 247, 139 NW 498.

Reimbursement by state must not exceed the amount of premiums paid by the society. OAG July 7, 1943 (772-A-6).

An entry fee need not be charged to exhibitors competing for a premium. OAG Nov. 9, 1945 (772-A-6).

Reimbursements by the state applies only to premiums paid at the annual fair. OAG Jan. 3, 1946 (772-C-9).

Money paid by an association to poultry raisers for poultry not exhibited at the fair is disregarded in determining amount to which the association is entitled to reimbursement by state. OAG July 24, 1946 (772-G).

38.15 SITES AND BUILDINGS.

Tax levy may be made by county board for aid to county agricultural society. OAG, May 10, 1933 (772-A-1).
