# 415.01 LAWS RELATING TO TOWNS NOT TO APPLY TO TERRITORY IN VILLAGES OR CITIES.

#### 415.03 PUBLICATION OF VILLAGE PROCEEDINGS.

The formalities as to signing, attesting, and publishing prescribed by section 412.22 for ordinances, rules, and by-laws need not be so strictly complied with in the case of resolutions adopted by the council. Davies v Village of Madelia, 205 M 526, 287 NW 1.

By terms of the statute, and by the terms of the ordinance, it did not become operative until publication thereof, the president of the council refused to sign, the clerk refused to attest, there was no publication, and the ordinance repealed and rescinded before it was put in operation. The fact that the plaintiff accepted the terms of the ordinance is immaterial. The mandamus action cannot be maintained. Union Service Co. v Village of Minneota, 212 M 92, 2 NW(2d) 555.
