OFFICERS AND EMPLOYEES

418.025 VILLAGE ASSESSORS.

Town assessor is paid by the town; not by the village located in the town. OAG July 21, 1944 (12-B-1).

A village council may fix the assessor's salary on an annual basis. Unless the village fixes the compensation of a deputy, and authorizes its payment, the deputy must be paid by the assessor. The village is not liable. OAG Feb. 11, 1947 (R.C.) (12 B-1) (12 E).

418.12 BOARD OF POLICE COMMISSIONERS IN CERTAIN CITIES OF FOURTH CLASS.

Subdivision 2, amended by L. 1947 c. 470 s. 1.

There is no statutory provision for the removal from office of a commissioner. He must therefore serve out his term. OAG March 8, 1946 (785-D).

Member of police commission, school board, planning board, common council, or one holding the office of mayor, cannot be a member of the charter commission. OAG Feb. 4, 1947 (358-E-1).
