REVISOR OF STATUTES

482.01 CREATION.

Where the statutory language is clear and unambiguous, there is no room for construction or interpretation. When in 1945 the legislature adopted and enacted the compilation and revision of the general statutes of this state as the "Minnesota Revised Statutes," it thereby recognized and declared the same to be an official compilation, revision, and code. As such the language chosen and used in the revised statutes must be given effect as the latest expression of the legislative will. State ex rel v Washburn, 224 M 269, 28 NW(2d) 652.
