#### CHAPTER 490

### RETIREMENT OF JUDGES

# 490.01 RETIREMENT OF SUPREME COURT JUSTICES AND DISTRICT COURT JUDGES.

Where a district judge on October 1 resigned, his resignation to be effective November 15, the governor having no power to declare a vacancy, accepted the resignation and appointed a successor to take office on November 16, and there was no vacancy in the office on election day November 3. State ex rel v Holm, 202 M 500, 279 NW 218.

## 490.02 RETIREMENT OF SUPREME COURT JUSTICES AND DISTRICT COURT JUDGES.

In case of the retirement of a district judge the original affidavit of retirement should be filed with the secretary of state, a copy thereof should be filed with the state auditor, and a copy should be enclosed in a letter to the governor. OAG Nov. 20, 1944 (141-D-5).

### 490.027 RETIREMENT COMPENSATION NOT INCREASED.

Section 490.027 limits the retirement compensation to one-half of the salary in force immediately prior to the enactment of L. 1945, c. 507. OAG Jan. 2, 1947 (141-D-5).
