CHAPTER 520

UNIFORM FIDUCIARIES ACT

NOTE: The uniform fiduciaries act was adopted and recommended by the national conference of commissioners on uniform state laws in 1922. It was adopted and enacted in Minnesota by L. 1945, c. 202. It has been adopted in the following states: Alabama, Colorado, District of Columbia, Hawaii, Idaho, Illinois, Indiana, Louisiana, Maryland, Minnesota, Nevada, New Jersey, New Mexico, North Carolina, Ohio, Pennsylvania, South Dakota, Utah, Wisconsin, Wyoming.
