CONSTRUCTION STATUTES RELATING TO EVIDENCE

602.01 CERTAIN STATEMENTS PRESUMED TO BE FRAUDULENT.

Independent of the question whether the statement was fraudulent under this section, where the plaintiff made a statement contradictory to his testimony at the time of trial as to how the accident occurred, testified and produced evidence that at the time the earlier statement was made his mental and physical condition due to pain and the administration of drugs may have misstated the facts, probative value of the statement was for the consideration of the jury. *Aide v Taylor*, 214 M 212, 7 NW(2d) 757.
