# 637.01 INDETERMINATE SENTENCES AND PAROLES

#### CHAPTER 637

### INDETERMINATE SENTENCES AND PAROLES

### 637.01 TERM OF SENTENCE.

Under section 610.17, sentences to confinement in St. Cloud reformatory for less than one year were erroneous and warden would be advised to construe such sentences as maximum sentences subject to diminution as provided in section 640.43. OAG Feb. 8, 1946 (341-K-2).

Expense of treatment and care of a prisoner at liberty on commuted sentence who was shot while attempting to commit a crime should be handled as a case of any other pauper in the county. OAG Oct. 15, 1946 (91-H).

Banishment, validity of provision in sentence. 31 MLR 742.

### 637.02 PAROLE BOARD.

Under this section the board, finding the sheriff in another state, may defray the expense of the sheriff for returning a parole violator located in said other state, to Minnesota, and this notwithstanding the provisions of section 637.06. OAG Sept. 13, 1945 (328-A-1).

### 637.06 POWERS OF BOARD: LIMITATIONS.

It is no part of the official duty of a sheriff to pick up a violator and return him to the custody of the state parole board. The sheriff may receive compensation for such service. OAG Sept. 13, 1945 (328-A-1).

Neither the director of public institutions nor the board of parole is authorized by law to pay hospitalization expense of parolee. The parolee is primarily liable and if unable to pay the hospital or physician may seek compensation under the poor laws. OAG Oct. 25, 1946 (91-H).

## 637.08 DUTY OF BOARD; FINAL DISCHARGE.

A convict released on a conditional pardon is not entitled to restoration of civil rights. OAG Feb. 25, 1943 (68-H).

# 637.10 SUPERVISION BY BOARD; AGENTS.
