GAME REFUGES AND GAME AND FUR FARMS

99.25 GAME REFUGES; ESTABLISHMENT AND VACATION.

If a deer is killed upon posted land, it belongs to the state and not to the killer of the deer or the property owner. If a deer is shot on non-posted property and dies on posted property, and the owner of the posted property claims it, the killer of the deer must resort to ordinary civil remedies to recover the carcass. 1942 OAG 7, Dec. 1, 1942 (210-D-2).

The general penalty clause, section 97.55, applies to violations under chapter 99. 1944 OAG 47, Oct. 19, 1943 (208-G).

To establish a valid game refuge the provisions of sections 99.25 and 99.26 must be complied with. OAG Jan. 12, 1944 (210-c-2).
