Where dealers operating on east coast of the United States, a Minnesota provision company, and a trucking company licensed in Pennsylvania entered into a joint enterprize, the trucks were delivered to the Minneapolis company, who loaded them with eggs and turned the loaded trucks over to the Pennsylvania driver, who delivered the eggs to the New York dealer, the New York produce dealer was not required to post a wholesaler's license, and the eggs must be candled by the Minnesota company. OAG Feb. 27, 1952 (832-J-1).
