COUNTY AND CITY HOSPITALS

377.01 HOSPITALS AND ALMSHOUSES IN COUNTIES HAVING A BOARD OF CONTROL

A city may enter into a contract with the Minnesota hospital service association under which the association may settle the claim of the hospital at a discount. OAG July 13, 1949 (1001-A).

CHAPTER 379

ORGANIZATION, FORMATION, AND PARTITION OF TOWNS AND ALTERATION OF THEIR BOUNDARIES

379.01 ORGANIZATION

Where a town was dissolved under section 368.47 a petition may be made under section 379.01 asking for the organization of the area as a town. Section 379.01 is a statute granting a right. A specified number of legal voters in a specified area may petition the county board to be organized as a town. The county board is required to act on the petition but, under section 368.47, it is optional with the board to dissolve a town that fails to meet the requirements contained therein. OAG April 1, 1949 (441-B).

CHAPTER 380

COUNTY BOARDS OF CERTAIN COUNTIES

380.02 ESTABLISHMENT

A written permit must be obtained from the water pollution control commission as required by section 144.377 before a contract can be regularly entered into by the county for the construction or extension of a disposal plant. OAG Oct. 14, 1948 (225-M).

380.03 WORK TO BE LET

Municipal corporations, right of taxpayer to enjoin or avoid a contract awarded on competitive bidding where an officer is interested. 35 MLR 322.
