

## 368.01 TOWNS; SPECIAL PROVISIONS

**Subd. 30. Notice to county auditor.** The town clerk of each town exercising special powers pursuant to this section shall so notify in writing the county auditor of the county wherein such town is located. The written notice shall be filed by the county auditor as a public record.

The board of supervisors in any town may employ an attorney and pay up to \$1,000 in attorney's fees annually without an affirmative vote of or approval by the electors of such town.

#### 371.07 State canvassing board to canvass returns

The state canvassing board shall canvass such returns at the time of canvassing the votes cast for state officers, and in the same manner. When the canvass is completed the board shall make and file with the secretary of state its certificate declaring the result of the vote, showing the number of votes cast in each county for and against consolidation. If 60 percent of the votes cast thereon in each county affected by the proposed consolidation be in favor thereof, the secretary of state shall record the certificate and shall deliver a certified copy thereof to the governor, who shall issue a proclamation declaring the result. Upon the issuance of the proclamation by the governor the consolidation shall become effective and operative on the first day of January following such general election.
