Subd. 2. Each county in the district shall levy a special tax each year in order to defray its share of the cost of the activities of the commission, which share shall be based on population. Such levy where necessary may be made separate from the general levy of the county and may be made at any time of the year, however, no participating county shall levy any tax for mosquito control except under sections 399.01 to 399.12.

400.03 Definitions; option to include other materials as solid waste

Subd. 6. Any county may elect, by resolution of the county board, to include materials removed from sanitary sewage soil absorption systems within the definition of "solid waste" as it applies within the county. This subdivision shall supersede any local law, ordinance or regulation inconsistent herewith.

400.11 Tax levies; advance funding

The county may levy taxes for solid waste management purposes upon all taxable property within the county, which shall not affect the amount or rate of taxes which may be levied for other county purposes. The county may levy a tax in anticipation of need for solid waste management purposes as specified in the resolution levying the tax, appropriating the proceeds of the tax to a special fund to be used only for those purposes and, until used, to be invested in securities authorized in section 475.66.
