155.05 Members of board.

Membership terms, compensation of members, removal of members, the filling of membership vacancies, and fiscal year and reporting requirements shall be as provided in sections 214.07 to 214.09. Three of such members shall have an official seal, shall have had five years of experience within the last seven years and practice in this state in the occupation and practices as named within this chapter, and shall be senior instructors or have the qualifications to take the examination therefor, prior to the first appointment. The board members shall be citizens of this state and not members of, nor affiliated with, any school approved and teaching the practices, as defined herein, while a member of the board, nor shall any two members of the board be graduates of the same school, or system of schools, teaching the practices, as defined herein. Each member of the board shall take the oath provided by law for public officers.

155.06 Board, organization, rules, records, inspections.

Subdivision 1. The board shall each year elect from among its members a president, a vice-president, and a secretary-treasurer to serve until their successors are elected and have qualified. The board shall appoint such assistants, inspectors, and clerical help as it may deem necessary to perform the work of the board. The appointments shall be made in accordance with the rules and regulations to be adopted by the board and chosen upon the basis of experience, training, and general qualifications for the work. The board shall maintain an office for the conduct of its business. The secretary-treasurer of the board shall maintain its office and devote his entire time to the duties thereof and receive an annual salary of \$9,000.

Subd. 2. The board shall meet for the purpose of examining applicants for license and of examining and granting applications for license pursuant to the provisions of this chapter at times to be designated by the board. A quorum for the transaction of business of the board shall consist of three members of the board. The board shall have power to formulate rules for the proper administration of its business.

155.08 Compensation of board members.

Each member of the board except the secretary-treasurer shall be compensated for each day spent on board activities. Such days employed are not to exceed 100 days in any one year except that in the months when state board examinations are given this limitation will not apply.
