168C.11 Deputy registrars of bicycles.

168C.11 DEPUTY REGISTRARS OF BICYCLES.

Subdivision 1. **Appointment.** Subject to the provisions of subdivision 2, the commissioner shall appoint as deputy registrars of bicycles any bicycle dealer, or agent or employee thereof, or any agent or employee designated by a municipality that sells bicycles at public auction who applies for appointment in a manner prescribed by the commissioner; provided that concurrently there may be no more than one such deputy for each separate place of business of a bicycle dealer. Deputy registrars of bicycles shall act as agents of the commissioner and may accept registrations as provided in Laws 1976, Chapter 199, except that no deputy registrar of bicycles shall be required to register bicycles sold by other bicycle dealers. The commissioner, deputy registrars of motor vehicles, and deputy registrars of bicycles may charge and retain an additional \$1 per registration granted for their services. In the case of a deputy registrar of motor vehicles, the \$1 shall be deposited in the treasury of the place for which he is appointed, or if the deputy is not a public official he shall retain the filing fee. All other registration fees collected by the commissioner, deputy registrars of motor vehicles and deputy registrars of bicycles shall be processed, accounted for and transmitted to the state treasurer as required by the commissioner.
