32B.07 PROSPECTIVE FEES; MILK MARKETING PROGRAM.

Fees collected pursuant to sections 32B.01 to 32B.13 shall be deposited in a federally insured depository institution and shall be disbursed by the officers and employees approved by the commissioner of agriculture with the advice and consent of the council for the necessary expenses incurred with respect to sections 32B.01 to 32B.13. All persons authorized to control, handle, or deposit these fees shall be bonded. The amount, manner and payment of the bonds shall be the responsibility of the council. All fees collected by the first buyer of milk must be remitted within 30 days of collection of same.

32B.12 ACCEPTANCE OF FUNDS.

The commissioner of agriculture may accept funds, private and public, for the purpose of conducting a referendum or doing any other act or thing required under the terms and provisions of sections 32B.01 to 32B.13. Funds received for those purposes shall be deposited in the commodity research and promotion account.
