358.15 BY WHOM TAKEN IN THIS STATE.

The following named officers shall have power to take and certify acknowledgments within the state:

(1) every member of the legislature, while still a resident in the district from which he was elected; but he shall receive no fee or compensation for so doing. The form of his official signature in such cases shall be: "A.B., Representative (or Senator), District, Minnesota. My term expires January 1, 19.....;"

(2) the judges and clerks and deputy clerks of all courts, residing within the state, including those of the circuit and district courts of the United States, and resident United States commissioners;

(3) notaries public and the clerks or recorders of towns, and cities; and

(4) court commissioners, county recorders, and county auditors, and their several deputies, and county commissioners, all within their respective counties.
