368.01 Powers of certain metropolitan area towns.

368.01 POWERS OF CERTAIN METROPOLITAN AREA TOWNS.

Subd. 20. Departments: boards. The town board of supervisors may create departments and advisory boards and appoint officers, employees, and agents for the town as deemed necessary for the proper management and operation of town affairs. The town board may prescribe the duties and fix the compensation of all officers, both appointive and elective, employees, and agents, when not otherwise prescribed by law. The town board may require any officer or employee to furnish a bond conditioned for the faithful exercise of his duties and the proper application of, and payment upon demand of, all moneys officially received by him. Unless otherwise prescribed by law, the amount of the bonds shall be fixed by the town board. The bonds furnished by the clerk and treasurer shall be corporate surety bonds. The town board may provide for the payment from town funds of the premium on the official bond of any officer or employee of the town. The town board may, except as otherwise provided, remove any appointive officer or employee when in its judgment the public welfare will be promoted by the removal. This provision does not modify the laws relating to veterans preference or to members of a town police or fire civil service commission or public utilities commission.
