115.03 POWERS AND DUTIES.

Subd. 5a. **Public notice for national pollutant discharge elimination system permit application.** The director must give public notice of a completed national pollutant discharge elimination system permit application for new municipal discharges in the official county newspaper of the county where the discharge is proposed.

115.74 WATER SUPPLY AND WASTEWATER TREATMENT OPERATORS CERTIFICATION COUNCIL.

Subdivision 1. The water and wastewater treatment operators certification council shall be composed of six members. The commissioner of health shall appoint two members as follows: A currently employed water supply system operator holding a valid certificate issued by the commissioner; and a representative of the league of Minnesota cities. The director of the pollution control agency shall appoint two members as follows: a currently employed wastewater treatment facility operator holding a valid certificate issued by the director; and a university or college faculty member whose major field is related to water supply or wastewater collection and treatment. The remainder of the council shall be composed of the following persons: A representative of the state department of health who is either the director of the division of environmental health or a qualified member of his staff; the director of the Minnesota pollution control agency or a qualified member of his staff. In the case of the first council, the appointments of a water supply system operator and a wastewater treatment facility operator shall be made from currently employed operators holding valid certificates under the voluntary certification program administered by the state department of health and the Minnesota pollution control agency.
