205.13 Candidates, filing.

205.13 CANDIDATES, FILING.

Subdivision 1. **Affidavit of candidacy.** Not more than eight nor less than six weeks before the municipal primary, or before the municipal general election if there is no municipal primary, an individual who is eligible and desires to become a candidate for an office to be voted for at the election shall file an affidavit of candidacy with the municipal clerk. The affidavit shall be in substantially the same form as that in section 204B.06, subdivision 1. The municipal clerk shall also accept an application signed by not less than five voters and filed on behalf of an eligible voter in the municipality whom they desire to be a candidate, if service of a copy of the application has been made on the candidate and proof of service is endorsed on the application being filed. Upon receipt of the proper filing fee, the clerk shall place the name of the candidate on the official ballot without partisan designation.
