368.01 POWERS OF CERTAIN METROPOLITAN AREA TOWNS.

Subd. 1a. **Certain other towns.** Any town with a population of 1,000 or more that does not otherwise qualify pursuant to subdivision 1 to exercise the powers enumerated in this section, shall have and possess the enumerated powers upon an affirmative vote of the electors of the town at the annual town meeting. The population must be established by the most recent federal decennial census, special census as provided in section 368.015, or population estimate by the state demographer made according to section 116K.04, subdivision 4, whichever has the latest stated date of count or estimate.

368.015 TOWNS; CENSUS.

A town board may by resolution, in any year, request the United States Bureau of the Census to take a special census of the town for the purpose of being eligible to exercise the powers contained in section 368.01 as provided in section 368.01, subdivision 1a. A cost for the special census shall be borne by the town.

368.85 FIRE PROTECTION.

Subd. 6. **Tax levy.** The town board shall annually thereafter levy a tax in an amount as necessary on the assessed valuation of all property located within the special fire protection district to provide fire protection for the district. The tax, with a certified copy of the resolution establishing the district, shall be certified by the town board to the county auditor who shall spread the tax against the property located within the district. The tax shall be collected as other taxes.
