88.041 INTERSTATE FOREST FIRE PREVENTION AND SUPPRESSION AGREEMENTS.

The commissioner may enter into agreements with other states to cooperatively prevent and suppress forest fires.

88.43 FIRE-BREAKS; CLEARING LANDS.

Subd. 2. Benefits; assessment; lien. If any clearing or other improvement of land made by any town or city benefits any person, or benefits some and damages others, then the amount of both such benefits and damages shall be ascertained in the same manner as provided by law with respect to damages in condemnation proceedings by right of eminent domain. All provisions of law relating to the determination of the amount of damages in condemnation proceedings shall apply to the determination of the value of benefits under this section, as far as practicable. Any benefits so found shall be assessed against, and be a lien upon, the real property so benefited and shall be noted upon the public records and collected upon the same terms and in substantially the same manner as now provided by law for the collection of ditch and drainage assessments pursuant to sections 106A.005 to 106A.811.

88.80 ASPEN RECYCLING PROGRAM.

The commissioner may establish and accelerate an aspen recycling program to assure that marketable stands of aspen are available on state lands and may designate priority areas on state lands for aspen recycling.
