116E.03 POWERS AND DUTIES.

Subd. 9. Private grant and federal funds. The chief administrative officer of the state board is the state agent to apply for, receive, and disburse private grant and federal funds made available to the state by private organizations or federal law or rules and regulations promulgated thereunder for any purpose related to the powers and duties of the state board or the regional councils. The chief administrative officer shall comply with any and all requirements of such private organizations or federal law or such rules and regulations promulgated thereunder to enable the funds to be applied for, received, and disbursed. All such moneys received by the chief administrative officer of the state board shall be deposited in the state treasury and are hereby annually appropriated to the chief administrative officer for the purposes for which they are received. None of such moneys in the state treasury shall cancel and they shall be available for expenditure in accordance with the requirements of federal law or the terms of such private grants. No application for federal funds or private grants under this subdivision shall be submitted to federal authorities or private organizations for approval unless the proposed budget for the expenditure of such funds is approved by the governor and reported to the standing committee on finance of the senate and the standing committee on appropriations of the house of representatives.
