Subdivision 1. Notwithstanding any law or rule of court to the contrary, a petit jury is a body of six persons impaneled and sworn in any court to try and determine, by a true and unanimous verdict, any question or issue of fact in a civil or criminal action or proceeding, according to law and the evidence as given them in court.
