376.09 Aid to hospitals in counties having no county hospital.

**376.09 AID TO HOSPITALS IN COUNTIES HAVING NO COUNTY HOSPITAL.**

In any county in which there is no county hospital, the county board may appropriate and pay money from the general fund of the county, for the construction, maintenance, and operation of a private, nonprofit, or public hospital in the county for the treatment of sick, diseased, and injured persons. Admission preference shall always be given to patients who are, in whole or in part, public charges, and are sent to the hospital by the county board.
