447.10 TAX LEVY FOR OPERATING AND MAINTAINING HOSPITAL.

The governing body of a city of the first class owning a hospital may annually levy a tax to operate and maintain the hospital. The tax must not exceed 0.00806 percent of taxable market value.

447.34 PAYMENT OF EXPENSES; TAXATION.

Subd. 2. **Deciding and certifying tax amount.** On or before October 10 of each year the hospital board shall decide the amount necessary to be raised from ad valorem tax levies to meet its expenses. No later than October 10 the secretary of the hospital board shall certify that amount to the county auditor of each county containing territory in the hospital district. Each county auditor shall assess and extend upon the tax rolls for the year that portion of the certified amount that bears the same ratio to the whole amount as the net tax capacity of taxable property in that part of the hospital district located in the auditor's county bears to the net tax capacity of all taxable property in the hospital district.
