The Minnesota public facilities authority consists of the commissioner of trade and economic development, the commissioner of finance, the commissioner of the pollution control agency, and three additional members appointed by the governor from the general public with the advice and consent of the senate.

- Subd. 2. Other responsibilities. (a) The responsibilities for the health care equipment loan program under Minnesota Statutes 1986, section 116M.07, subdivisions 7a, 7b, and 7c, are transferred from the Minnesota energy and economic development authority to the Minnesota public facilities authority.
- (b) Except as otherwise provided in this paragraph, section 15.039 applies to the transfer of responsibilities. The transfer includes 8-1/2 positions from the financial management division of the department of trade and economic development to the community development division of the department of trade and economic development.
