44A.01 WORLD TRADE CENTER CORPORATION.

Subd. 2. Board membership. The corporation is governed by a board of directors consisting of:

- (1) four members, representing the international business community, elected to six-year terms by the association of members established under section 44A.023, subdivision 2, clause (5);
- (2) four members, representing the international business community, appointed by the governor, to serve at the governor's pleasure;
- (3) the mayor of St. Paul or the mayor's designee; and
- (4) the commissioners of trade and economic development, agriculture, and commerce.

Members appointed by the governor must be knowledgeable or experienced in international trade in products or services.

Subd. 4. Organization. The board shall elect a chair from the representatives of the international business community appointed by the governor, and an executive committee from its members.

44A.025 DUTIES.

The board shall:

- (1) promote and market the Minnesota world trade center;
- (2) sponsor conferences or other promotional events in the conference and service center;
- (3) adopt bylaws governing operation of the corporation by November 1, 1987;
- (4) conduct public relations and liaison activities between the corporation and the international business community;
- (5) establish and maintain an office in the Minnesota world trade center; and
- (6) not duplicate programs or services provided by the commissioner of trade and economic development, the Minnesota trade division, or the commissioner of agriculture.
