### **365.46 NOTICE TO SECRETARY OF STATE, OTHERS; RECORDING.**

Subd. 2. Copies. The county auditor shall also send a copy of the notice of the dissolution to: (1) the state demographer, (2) the Land Management Information Center, (3) the director of the Office of Strategic and Long-Range Planning, and (4) the commissioner of transportation.

#### 365.52 SPECIAL MEETING; FOR ANY LAWFUL PURPOSE.

Subdivision 1. How called; statement; petition. A special town meeting may be held to conduct any lawful business. To call a special meeting, the supervisors and town clerk, or any two of them together with at least 12 other town freeholders, shall file a statement in the town clerk's office. The statement must tell why the meeting is called, the particular business to be transacted, and that the interests of the town require the meeting. A special town meeting may also be called on petition of 20 percent of the electors of the town. The percentage is of the number of voters at the last general election.
