609B.170 LAWFUL GAMBLING AND GAMBLING DEVICES LICENSES; DISQUALIFICATIONS.

- (a) Under section 349.155, in the case of licenses for manufacturers, distributors salespersons, linked bingo game providers, and gambling managers, the Gambling Control Board may not issue or renew a license under chapter 349, and shall revoke a license under chapter 349, if the applicant or licensee, or a director, officer, partner, governor, or person in a supervisory or management position of the applicant or licensee has been convicted of:
 - (1) a felony or a crime involving gambling;
 - (2) assault;
 - (3) a criminal violation involving the use of a firearm; or
 - (4) making terroristic threats.
- (b) Under section 349.155, in the case of licenses for organizations, the Gambling Control Board may not issue or renew a license under chapter 349, and shall revoke a license under chapter 349, if the organization or an officer or member of the governing body of the organization has been convicted of:
 - (1) a felony or gross misdemeanor involving theft or fraud; or
 - (2) a crime involving gambling.
