336.9-306B LAW GOVERNING PERFECTION AND PRIORITY OF SECURITY INTERESTS IN CONTROLLABLE ACCOUNTS, CONTROLLABLE ELECTRONIC RECORDS, AND CONTROLLABLE PAYMENT INTANGIBLES.

- (a) **Governing law: general rules.** Except as provided in subsection (b), the local law of the controllable electronic record's jurisdiction specified in section 336.12-107(c) and (d) governs perfection, the effect of perfection or nonperfection, and the priority of a security interest in a controllable electronic record and a security interest in a controllable account or controllable payment intangible evidenced by the controllable electronic record.
- (b) When perfection governed by law of jurisdiction where debtor located. The local law of the jurisdiction in which the debtor is located governs:
- (1) perfection of a security interest in a controllable account, controllable electronic record, or controllable payment intangible by filing; and
- (2) automatic perfection of a security interest in a controllable payment intangible created by a sale of the controllable payment intangible.
