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- § 7. Period of limitation to continue to run. When a limitation or period of time prescribed in any of the acts repealed, for acquiring a right or barring a remedy, or any other purpose, has begun to run, and the same or similar limitation is prescribed in the General Statutes, the time of limitation shall continue to run, and shall have like effect as if the whole period had begun and ended under the operation of the General Statutes.

 § 8. Tenure of offices preserved. All persons who, at the time when said repeal takes

All persons who, at the time when said repeal takes effect, hold any office under any of the acts repealed, shall continue to hold the same according to the tenure thereof, except those offices which have been abolished, and those as to which a different provision is made by the General Statutes
- § 9. General Statutes to be construed as continuation of former laws. The provisions of the General Statutes, so far as they are the same as those of existing laws, shall be construed as a continuation of such laws, and not as new enactments; and references, in laws not repealed, to provisions of laws incorporated into the General Statutes, and repealed, shall be construed as applying to the same provisions so incorporated.

CHAPTER CXXII.

OF THE EXPRESS REPEAL OF EXISTING LAWS.

TITLE I.

CONVEYANCES DEFECTIVELY EXECUTED, ACKNOWLEDGED, OR RECORDED.

*§ 1. Acknowledgments before territorial clerks of supreme or district courts or judges of probate. The acknowledgment of the execution of any grant or conveyance of lands, or of any estate or interest therein, by deed, mortgage or otherwise, heretofore made and taken before any clerk of either the supreme or district courts and judges of probate of this territory, and the certificate of every such acknowledgment made by any such clerk shall have the same force and effect as evidence and entitle such grant or conveyance to be recorded in the same manner and with the like effect in all respects as though the same had been duly acknowledged in pursuance of the laws of this territory. In all cases where any such grant or conveyance, acknowledged as aforesaid, shall have been recorded, the record
