

This book contains the laws of a general and permanent nature enacted at the 1981 Regular Session and 1981 Special Sessions of the 72nd legislature. It supplements Minnesota Statutes 1980 which embraces the laws of a general and permanent nature in force at the close of the 1980 session of the legislature.

Laws that amend sections or subdivisions in Minnesota Statutes 1980 are published with the numbers of the amended sections and subdivisions. Where all subdivisions of a particular section are not included in this supplement, their omission is indicated in the following manner: [For text of subds 3 and 4, see M.S. 1980]. New laws have been classified and numbered in conformity with the numbering system of Minnesota Statutes. Repeals of sections and subdivisions of Minnesota Statutes 1980 are shown. At the beginning of each chapter of the supplement is a list of sections included which are new or have been amended or repealed.

All statutory text in this supplement is indexed, whether new or amended.

CONSTITUTION OF THE STATE OF  
MINNESOTA

ARTICLE VII  
Section 9

Sec. 9. **Campaign spending limits.** The amount that may be spent by candidates for constitutional and legislative offices to campaign for nomination or election shall be limited by law. The legislature shall provide by law for disclosure of contributions and expenditures made to support or oppose candidates for state elective offices. [Adopted, November 4, 1980]
