

**134A.17 TRANSFERS TO COUNTY.**

Subdivision 1. **Sherburne County.** If the Sherburne County Law Library, through its trustees, has a fiscal reserve that is projected to sustain its operations for a period of over five years, the Sherburne County Law Library may transfer up to half of the money in its fiscal reserve, but not to exceed \$200,000, to Sherburne County to defray costs of constructing a new building to house the law library and courts.

Subd. 2. **Polk County.** If at any time the Polk County Law Library, through its trustees, has a fiscal reserve that is projected to sustain its operations for a period of over five years, the Polk County Law Library may transfer up to half of the money in its fiscal reserve, but not to exceed \$150,000, to Polk County to defray costs of technological improvements to the Polk County Courthouse.
